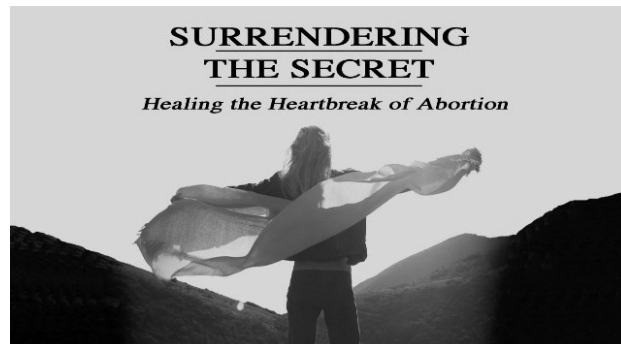

At a planning meeting recently, each person present was asked why they are involved in the ministry of the pregnancy center. I (Becky Deas, Executive Director) asked Dr. Hobby to share his story:

Here is why I am involved in the PSC ministry...We frequently see our military as heroes and they are. I want to share with you one of my heroes.

My mother had a normal pregnancy with my sister and then had a complicated pregnancy with my brother who died at two weeks secondary to congenital heart disease. Two years later, she again became pregnant and was strongly advised to have a medical abortion because of possible severe medical complications. She refused and had severe problems with high blood pressure and was in bed for a total of four months during her pregnancy. I was told of her sacrifice by my aunt at 8-10 years of age when mother had to be admitted to the hospital. My mother was a committed Christian and I believe she understood that each life is a gift from God. We did discuss her beliefs and that THE BIBLE is the ordained Word of God. I believe that she understood Psalm 139:13, “For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.”

My mother died at age 44 from a cerebral hemorrhage soon after my 17th birthday. This was due to a medical complication that began as a result of her pregnancy with me. I feel she made a sacrifice that was based on her love of an unborn child (me) and her commitment to JESUS. I never told her thank you, but I will be able to one day as I believe we are only travelers in what we call life and will meet again in heaven. Because I was raised in a Christian home and saw my mother's commitment to God, I did not have to say "good bye" when she died, but only "see you later". When I am able to serve the PSC, I am saying “thank you” to Mom.

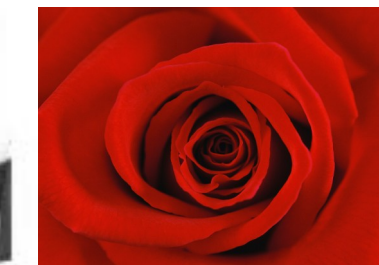
