Greater Things are YET to Come!

The PSC's 19th Annual Fundraising Dinner featuring **Gwen Smith** was an outstanding evening. The audience of 568 were reminded, through the testimonies of our clients and through **Gwen's** own story, that as a local mission to the community of Valdosta all we do points to Christ! As stated by a client interviewed in our new promotional video, "I was lost, but now I am found. You [PSC] saved my life...no, actually, Jesus saved my life, but you introduced me to Him!"

The keynote speaker of the evening was singer, worship leader, and author, **Gwen Smith**. Gwen shared the story of a typical American girl who made a few poor choices that ultimately ended in an abortion. Gwen then revealed that she was that typical American college student. Her testimony highlighted the healing that only comes from "The God of the Great Exchange!" She also mentioned the important part that post abortion support groups played in her healing process. Citing that 30-35% of women will have had an abortion by the time they were 45, Gwen gave the visual that statistically equated to 1/3 of the women and men sitting in the audience.
